Facts & Stats

Use these Facts and Statistics to Talk about the Importance of Your Drive

- Since 2018, HomeAid National Capital Region has collected over 750,000 diapers and wipes, delivering them to over 30 local nonprofit partners.
- Diapers and wipes cannot be purchased using Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Women, Infants and Children (WIC).
- Babies who remain in soiled diapers for too long are exposed to potential health risks.
- Five million babies and toddlers live in poor and low-income families. Diaper need is a hidden consequence of poverty.
- Households experiencing diaper needs are on average short 50 diapers per month.
- Daycares require that parents provide diapers. If they don't have enough diapers that means no daycare, no work, and no paycheck.
- Newborns use up to 12 diapers per day, at a cost of over \$100 per month per baby - a cost many families cannot afford.

Host Checklist

- Sign-up to host a diaper drive on HomeAid's website
- Pick up your collection box at HomeAid's office located at 3684 Centerview Drive, Suite 110B, Chantilly, VA 20151
- Place collection box in the front lobby or breakroom of office
- Create fun ways to involve your employees:
 - Offer an incentive, i.e. a day off or raffle tickets
 - Pick a theme for your diaper drive
 - Display a playpen to collect diapers and wipes
 - Set a goal to stuff a company vehicle or office
 - Build a structure/house with the diaper boxes
 - Have a team member announce the daily count
 - Use a thermometer to track progress
- Post the HomeAid's Builders for Babies flyer
- Share about your drive on social media
- Send reminder emails throughout the drive
- Take lots of photos throughout the collection
- Schedule your drop-off time on Friday, June 20th
 - Everyone participating in the diaper drive will be emailed to schedule their drop-off time
